

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, stating for the record that the information contained in the final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Assessment and Addendum, Project No. 31245, including any comments received during the public review process, has been previously reviewed and considered by this Council and it is determined that this subsequent discretionary approval of the Application for Federal Grant Supporting Open Space Brush Management Program does not involve substantial

changes or new information of substantial importance which would warrant any additional environmental review.
