WHEREAS, Florence Byerly Covell is still avidly interested in world affairs, international politics, and new discoveries in science and technology; and

WHEREAS, Florence Byerly Covell has been a well respected and important resident of The White Sands of La Jolla for 21 years; NOW, THEREFORE,
