WHEREAS, JANET WOOD later became part of the Financial Management Department as a budget analyst, and then became a community development specialist for economic development, which was then part of the Property Department, and was immediately involved with community revitalization and small business assistance; and

WHEREAS, JANET WOOD joined forces with community members on the creation of several neighborhood signs as well as to further the expansion and formation of the Hillcrest and El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement Districts; and

WHEREAS, JANET WOOD coordinated the design process and construction of various projects, including the community garden and Alice Birney Elementary School gate, landscaped medians in University Heights, on El Cajon Boulevard, and in Linda Vista, as well as Golden Hill streetscapes at Beech Street Square and Grape Street Plaza; and

WHEREAS, JANET WOOD worked on several projects in Linda Vista, joined the Livable Neighborhood Team, and was one of the original members of Linda Vista Collaborative; and

WHEREAS, JANET WOOD performed and coordinated business outreach programs with the University of San Diego and supported numerous Bayside Community Center activities; and

WHEREAS, JANET WOOD will be sorely missed upon her retirement and on November 18th, she will be honored and thanked for her 33 years of devoted service to the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize JANET WOOD and commends her for her dedication and contributions to the City of San Diego.
