

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 301081

ADOPTED ON NOV 28 2005

WHEREAS, Article XV, section 270(d) of the City Charter, effective January 1, 2006, provides that the City Council shall have the right to determine its own rules and order of business; and

WHEREAS, the Permanent Rules of the City Council, codified at San Diego Municipal Code section 22.0101.5, effective January 1, 2006, provide at Rule 4.3 that the Council President shall select a Council President Pro Tem, subject to confirmation by a majority of the Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council found it necessary to select one of its members to serve as Council President-elect prior to January 1, 2006, in order to assist with a smooth transition to the new office of Council President; and

WHEREAS, on November 22, 2005, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-301063, selecting Councilmember Scott Peters as Council President-elect to begin a one year term commencing on January 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now finds it necessary to select the Council President Pro Tem in order to give the President Pro Tem ample time to prepare for his or her new role as well as the new form of government, and to remain consistent with the past practice of naming new Council leadership during the previous legislative year; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that pursuant to section 22.0101.5 of the Municipal Code of the City of San Diego, the appointment by the Council President-elect of Councilmember Tony Young to serve as Council President Pro Tem of said City for the period commencing January 1, 2006, and lasting for a term of one year and until a successor is selected and qualified, is hereby confirmed.
