

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 301083

ADOPTED ON NOV 28 2005

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2005, following the resignation of Mayor Dick Murphy in July 2005, the City Council created the temporary office of Mayor Pro Tem and appointed Councilmember Jim Madaffer to the position; and

WHEREAS, one of the duties of the Mayor Pro Tem has been to oversee the vacant offices of Council Districts 2 and 8 and supervise the remaining staff members as they respond to the needs of constituents; and

WHEREAS, the position of Mayor Pro Tem will terminate on December 5, 2005, after the new Mayor is sworn in, and the oversight of the vacant district offices will revert to Deputy Mayor Toni Atkins until December 31, 2005, and then on January 1, 2006, to a newly selected Council President Pro Tem; and

WHEREAS, the run-off elections to fill the vacant council seats in Districts 2 and 8 will occur on January 10, 2006, and the new councilmembers will be sworn in shortly thereafter; and

WHEREAS, to maintain consistency and efficiency, the City Council has determined that Councilmember Jim Madaffer should continue to oversee the vacant district offices until the new councilmembers are elected and sworn into office; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that Councilmember Jim Madaffer will continue to oversee the operation of the offices of Council District 2 and District 8 until new councilmembers are sworn into those offices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if due to some unforeseen complication, one or both of the vacant council district offices has not been filled by the end of January 2006, the City Council will revisit the above temporary assignment.
