BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the College Community Redevelopment Project Area Committee consisting

of persons named on the list of Project Area Committee members receiving the

highest number of votes attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by

this reference is hereby approved as constituting a representative Project Area

Committee.

2. That the Council hereby concurs that the election results of October 4, 2005 are

valid and binding in accordance with the procedures so adopted by Resolution

No. R-280718.

3. That this activity is not a "project" and is therefore not subject to CEQA pursuant

to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(2).
