

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 301094

ADOPTED ON DEC 05 2009

WHEREAS, in 1973, Bishop Roy Dixon answered God's call to the ministry and was ordained by late Bishop S.M. Couch, and now serves as Bishop to the Southern California 4th Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction overseeing thirty churches worldwide; and

WHEREAS, in December of 1985, Bishop Roy Dixon was led to establish San Diego's Faith Chapel Church of God in Christ (COGIC), which has grown from the initial 20 members to approximately 1,500 members and now includes the Holly Drive Community Development Corporation and Holly Drive Leadership Academy, which was established in 1999 and now serves over 100 students; and

WHEREAS, Bishop Roy Dixon established the Faith Fellowship of San Diego, which endeavored to reach out to disenfranchised Pastors who were not affiliated with any Jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Bishop Roy Dixon was President and Valedictorian of his senior class at University of California, Los Angeles; and

WHEREAS, by the mid 1960s, Bishop Roy Dixon was a successful entrepreneur and owned and operated a number of Dixon Burger Restaurants, and then he further developed his business holdings to include 12 Taco Bell shops; and


WHEREAS, Bishop Roy Dixon has served on numerous boards including the San Diego Organizing Project, the Holiday Bowl, and the San Diego Convention and Visitors Bureau, and

has given much of his life to the City of San Diego through leadership, sacrifice, and faith;
