WHEREAS, The City of San Diego Police Department will receive funding from the State of California for the Fiscal Year 2005/2006 "Citizen's Options for Public Safety," which was authorized in 1996 by Assembly Bill 3229, the purpose of which is to supplement front line law enforcement resources of local jurisdictions throughout the State, and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 3229 requires that the City Council appropriate and approve the use of these funds in accordance with the request of the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the Chief's request to the Council and his plans for the funds is through this 1472 request for Council Action; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police plans to use these funds for police automation, vehicle communications, safety, forensic, training, and miscellaneous equipment, maintenance and resources as needs are identified; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Auditor and the Chief of Police be and hereby are authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept and expend these Grant funds from the State of California.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the Auditor and the Chief of Police to execute all aspects of the program operation, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals, for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the State of California, and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to said program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall be used to supplement, and not to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and that personnel positions, if any, funded under this grant are not subject to local hiring freezes.
