WHEREAS, the Water Department has performed an in-depth cost analysis of its fees and charges and has determined that existing fees and charges do not recover the actual cost of providing the services; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council authorizes the changes to the Water Department fees and charges requiring Council approval as shown on City of San Diego Water Department Proposed Schedule of Fees and Charges dated

November 4, 2005, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and filed in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR
3011111 , which changes shall be effective on January 1, 2006.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council finds that the establishment or modification of these fees and charges are for the purpose of meeting operating expenses, and not for the funding of capital projects for the expansion of services, and therefore this activity is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15273.
