A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO APPLY, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND \$57,823 FOR THE ELDER ABUSE AND SAME SEX DOMESTIC VIOLENCE GRANT FOR AN ADDITIONAL SIX MONTHS

WHEREAS, beginning in 1998 the San Diego City Attorney's Office undertook a project designated the "Elder Abuse and Same Sex Domestic Violence Program" funded in part from funds made available through the "Violence Against Women Vertical Prosecution Program" administered by the State of California Office of Criminal Justice Planning [OCJP]; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney's Office has continued and desires to continue to undertake the project; and

WHEREAS, in January 2005, the City Attorney's Office received notification from the state of California Office of Emergency Services [OES] that the City had been awarded a grant in the amount of \$115,645 for Fiscal Year 2005 (July 1, 2004, through June 30, 2005); and

WHEREAS, in April 2005, the City Council authorized the City Attorney on behalf of the City to accept, appropriate, expend and administer the grant funds for Fiscal Year 2005 (July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005 as more particularly described in the document on file in the Office of the City Clerk as document No. RR-300272.

WHEREAS, in October 4, 2005, the City Attorney's Office received notification from the OES that the City's grant has been amended to change the end date from June 30, 2005 to December 31, 2005, as well as increasing the grant amount by \$57,823 (from \$115,645 to

\$173,468), increasing the grant match amount by \$19,274 (from \$19,274 to \$57,822), and increasing the total project cost by \$77,097 (from \$154,193 to \$231,290); and

WHEREAS, these grants require a 25 percent match by the City which has and will be met through existing staff salaries; and

WHEREAS, the project will continue to attend to the Elder Abuse and Same Sex Domestic Violence Program in the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the San Diego City Attorney, or designee, is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to apply for grant funding for the Elder Abuse and Same Sex Domestic Violence Program.
- 2. That the San Diego City Attorney, or designee, is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to execute and submit all documents necessary to comply with the grant requirements.
- 3. That the San Diego City Attorney, or designee, is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to accept \$57,823 in additional grant funding and to amend end date from June 30, 2005, to December 31, 2005, for the Elder Abuse and Same Sex Domestic Violence Program.
- 4. That the San Diego City Attorney, or designee, is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to accept, appropriate, expend, and administer the grant funds, if and when secured, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the grant program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to the terms and conditions of the grant program:

1. The City is authorized to appropriate all matching funds required for the project, including any amendments thereof.

- 2. Any liability arising out of the City's performance under these grants, including civil court actions for damages shall be the responsibility of the City.
- 3. All funds received pursuant to these grants shall be spent exclusively for the project and shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the City Council.
