AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-19396 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY INCREASING THE APPROPRIATION IN THE GENERAL FUND IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,100,000 BY REALLOCATING THE SALES TAX ALLOCATION SCHEDULED FOR STREETS DIVISION FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR USE BY THE STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION DIVISION.

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2005 the City Council adopted Resolution R-300928 to adopt City Manager Report No. 05-202, dated October 6, 2005, regarding the Fiscal Year 2006 financial status and budgetary update [Report]; and

WHEREAS, the Report made a budgetary recommendation under the caption entitled "Immediate Spending Needs," to fund \$1.5 million to hire an as-needed consultants for the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Division to perform necessary work to ensure or achieve compliance with various State requirements relating to water quality; and

WHEREAS, the City Auditor has identified specific funds that can be re-allocated to achieve these funding needs; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Appropriation Ordinance be amended by increasing the appropriation in the General Fund, Department 533, Storm Water Pollution Prevention Division by \$1,500,000 by re-allocating un-appropriated reserves in the General Fund.

Section 2. That the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Division is authorized to expend \$1,500,000.00 from the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Division General Fund 100, Dept. 533, for as-needed professional consultant services and project related costs to perform

Section 3. That the Council of the City of San Diego finds that this activity is not a project because this activity is a government fiscal activity which does not involve a commitment to a project that which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment, which is excluded from the definition of a project pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4), and is therefore not subject to from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon final passage.
