ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006-2007 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND \$250,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND UNAPPROPRIATED/UNALLOCATED RESERVE AND TRANSFER SAID AMOUNT TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FUND NO. 100 TO FUND POLICE OFFICER RECRUITMENT PROGRAM FOR THE SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO TAKE ACTIONS NECESSARY THEREFOR

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2006, the City Council adopted an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Adopting The Annual Budget For The Fiscal Year 2006-2007 And Appropriating The Necessary Money To Operate The City Of San Diego For Said Fiscal Year" [Annual Appropriation Ordinance]; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is facing a critical issue regarding the recruitment and retention of police officers; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has prepared a report entitled "San Diego Police Department Sworn Recruitment and Retention" [Report] to address police officer recruitment and retention; and

WHEREAS, the Report recommends, among other things, that funding be identified to retain a recruitment professional to assist the City develop a police officer recruitment program to enable the City to compete with surrounding jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends that the Police Department's recruitment budget be increased by \$250,000 to support police recruitment and retention efforts and further

recommends that such amount be appropriated from the General Fund Unappropriated

/Unallocated Reserve for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Annual Appropriation Ordinance is necessary in order

to authorize the Auditor and Comptroller to make the transfers recommended by the Mayor;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the recommendation of the Mayor is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to

appropriate \$250,000 from the Unappropriated/Unallocated Reserves to the Police, Department

110, such amount to be expended for the purposes stated herein.

Section 3. That a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final

passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day

prior to its final passage.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its

adoption after two public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in San Diego Charter

section 275.
