RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE REVISED PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR GRIT AERATION SYSTEMS AT POINT LOMA WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT; EXECUTING A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST BIDDER; ESTABLISHING PHASE FUNDING; TRANSFERRING AND EXPENDING FUNDS; AND FINDING NO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1 That the revised plans and specifications for the construction of the Grit Aeration Systems Project at the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. W.O. 179844, are approved.

2. That, after advertising for bids in accordance with law, the Mayor or his designee is authorized to establish contract funding phases and to award the above contract to the lowest responsible and reliable bidder in an amount not to exceed \$2,163,160, provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure under established contract funding phases are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

3 That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to transfer the amount of \$153,929 from Fund No. 41508, CIP 46-501.0, Annual Allocation – Metro Pooled Contingency, and the amount of \$336,071 from Fund No. 41509, CIP 46-218.0, Point Loma - S1 and S2 Digester Upgrades, to Fund No. 41508, CIP 45-943.0, Point Loma - Grit Processing Improvements Project.

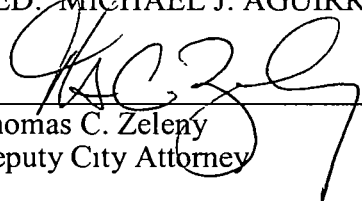
4. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$2,163,160 is authorized to provide funds for the above project and related costs, to be expended as follows. \$2,100,660 from Fund No. 41508, CIP 45-943.0, Point Loma Grit - Processing Improvements Project, for construction, construction management, and project related costs, and \$62,500 from Fund No 41508, CIP

46-501 0, Annual Allocation – Metro Pooled Contingency, for project contingency; provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves upon advice from the administering department.

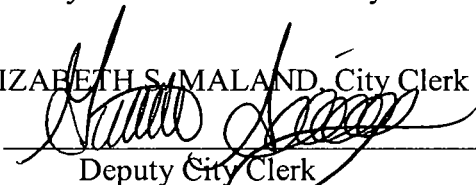
