BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor is authorized to apply for Highway Bridge Rehabilitation and Replacement (HBRR) grant funding for the purpose of designing and preparing an environmental document for the Voltaire Street Bridge Rehabilitation over Nimitz Boulevard project and to accept the Program Supplement to Local Agency-State Agreement for Federal Aid Project No. 5004 (150) in the amount of \$135,864.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a separate interest-bearing fund for the grant

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$135,864 from CIP No 52-519 0, Bridge Rails, HBRR, for the purpose of designing Voltaire Street Bridge over Nimitz Boulevard (Job Order 525233), contingent upon receipt of an FNM-76 (Version E-76) Caltrans Funding Authorization and the Auditor and Comptroller first certifying that the funds are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this activity is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c)(2) because it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and that any construction activities related to this approval will be subject to environmental review.


