WHEREAS, the City of San Diego continues its leadership in energy conservation and its commitment to improving energy efficiency in City facilities, which has resulted in avoiding 24 million kilowatt hours, saving \$3.5 million dollars each year, and reducing carbon dioxide emissions by 12.037 metric tons; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego was honored with a 2005 California Flex Your Power Award in recognition of its outstanding efforts in energy conservation and the efficient use of energy in public facilities; and

WHEREAS, prestigious EPA Energy Stars have been awarded to the Rancho Bernardo, Carmel Mountain, and Central libraries, and to the World Trade Center and Ridgehaven office buildings, in recognition of each facility ranking among the top 25 percent most energy efficient buildings nationwide; and

WHEREAS, by implementing the Sustainable Building Policy, committing to design and construction at the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design LEED-Silver level, San Ysidro's Fire Station 29 and the George L. Stevens Senior Center are 28 percent more energy efficient than California Energy Code Title 24 (2005) requirements; and

WHEREAS, 200 kilowatts of photovoltaic arrays have been installed on City facilities, demonstrating the City's support in achieving 50 megawatts of installed renewable energy generating capacity within City limits by the year 2013; and

WHEREAS, an innovative Solar Power Purchase Agreement leverages tax credits, State self-generation incentive programs, and a public-private partnership to provide clean power generated by solar panels for Alvarado Water Filtration Plant without contributing to air pollution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, reaffirms the City of San Diego's partnerships with the U.S. Department of Energy, Environmental Protection Agency, U.S. Green Building Council, California Flex Your Power, and San Diego Gas & Electric for the purpose of creating a sustainable future that supports environmental quality, economic security, and quality of life for all; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the week of March 6 through March 10, 2006, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "ENERGY EFFICIENCY AWARENESS WEEK" in the City of San Diego.
