A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD.

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board is responsible for the administration of the State of California's waste tire enforcement program. As part of the program, the Board is authorized to award grants from its Waste Tire Fund to solid waste Local Enforcement Agencies, cities, and counties that have regulatory authority to perform compliance, surveillance, and enforcement activities at waste tire facilities; and

WHEREAS, in November 1997, the California Integrated Waste Management Board authorized the City of San Diego Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) to carry out the duties and responsibilities of solid waste inspection, permitting, and enforcement within the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the LEA has received grant funds from the California Integrated Waste Management Board for waste tire enforcement annually since 1999 and has submitted an application for a grant of up to \$157,744.00 to the Board for continued implementation of its waste tire enforcement program for the period of June 30, 2006 to June 30, 2007. This program

provides guidance to waste tire generators, haulers, and facilities and enables the LEA to take enforcement actions if necessary to protect public health and the environment; and

WHEREAS, the LEA has demonstrated it has sufficient staff resources, technical expertise, and experience with similar projects to carry out the proposed program; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board requires the City

Council to authorize certain matters by resolution prior to the funding of the grant application;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and empowered to take all necessary actions to secure funds from the California Integrated Waste Management Board to implement the LEA's waste tire enforcement program, including but not limited to applications, grant agreements, amendments, and payment requests that may be necessary to carry out and administer the City's obligations, responsibilities and duties under the terms and conditions of the grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to accept and expend the grant funds, if awarded, for the purposes set forth in this resolution; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to create a separate fund for the grant monies.
