WHEREAS, SHIRLEY PHILLIPS' professionalism, dedication, and contributions to the cultural fabric of the City of San Diego will endure; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby commends SHIRLEY PHILLIPS for her accomplishments and service to the San Diego Museum of Man and wishes her all the best in her retirement.
