WHEREAS, Partners For Livable Places was founded in 1977 in Washington D.C. with the goal of promoting the concept of public/private partnerships, resulting in enhancing the quality of life in our nation's communities, and

WHEREAS, in 1982, the San Diego City Council approved establishment of San Diego as a "Partners for Livable Places Pilot City" to help create strategies to assist the City of San Diego to better evolve as a truly "livable" community as part of the Economics of Amenities program, and

WHEREAS, for nearly 25 years, Partners For Livable Places / San Diego has been a community catalyst promoting parks, historic areas, cultural facilities, and festivals, and has shown how a revitalized downtown contributes to the economic health of a community and the marketability of a city, and

WHEREAS, Partners For Livable Places / San Diego most recently helped the City's Commission for Arts and Culture by providing consulting and funding for a public art enhancement of the Cesar Chavez Trolley Station, and

WHEREAS, Partners For Livable Places / San Diego has presented the "Greening the City: Love It & Leaf It" Symposium as a forum for continued collaboration among key government policy and community leaders, including the Port of San Diego, San Diego County, Centre City Development Corporation, U.S. Navy, University of California, Citizens Coordinate for Century 3 [C3], San Diego Horticultural Society, Downtown Partnership, and the City of

San Diego, to provide the City of San Diego with insights into how "greening" our City can produce strong economic, environmental, health, and social benefits, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, does hereby honor Partners for Livable Places / San Diego for raising our collective attention to the value of our urban parkland and for drawing national attention to the City of San Diego as a "Park Place."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that March 15, 2006, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "GREENING THE CITY DAY" in the City of San Diego.
