WHEREAS, CHRIS WOLFE, immediate past president of QUALCOMM Wireless Business Solutions, will be honored by the San Diego Art Institute [SDAI]/Museum of the Living Artist with their eighth annual Visuals Arts “Ginger” Award, recognizing his exceptional efforts in the visual arts in the San Diego region; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, April 29, 2006, the SDAI/Museum of the Living Artist will celebrate its 49th International Digital Awards Exhibition, the only all-media internationally promoted exhibition of its type in the region honoring award-winning artists, at an Opening Gala Reception sponsored by SONY; and

WHEREAS, CHRIS WOLFE’s commitment to community service includes his founding of the organization Americans for Energy Independence, which endeavors to end America’s dependence on imported foreign oil by the year 2025; and

WHEREAS, CHRIS WOLFE is a longtime supporter of the arts, having served as the president of the board of directors of SDAI/Museum of the Living Artist from 2001-2006; and

WHEREAS, CHRIS WOLFE understands the importance of arts and culture, has strived to encourage and promote the success of the visual arts in San Diego, and has worked to sustain arts in the region through strategic planning; NOW, THEREFORE,
