RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSFER AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL MODIFICATION AT FRAZEE ROADAND FRIARS ROAD

WHEREAS, the Transportation Engineering Division of the Engineering and Capital Projects Department has received requests from the community to improve the function of the traffic signals at the intersection of Friars Road and Frazee Road;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$75,000 from Fund 63022, J.O. No. 990348, Private and Other Contributions-CIP to CIP 68-011.0, Traffic Signals Modifications/Modernization.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to increase the Fiscal Year 2006 Capital Improvement Program budget in CIP 68-011.0, Traffic Signals Modifications/Modernization by \$75,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$75,000 from CIP 68-011.0, Traffic Signals Modifications/Modernization, for the design and construction of a traffic signal modification at Frazee Road and Friars Road, contingent upon the Auditor and Comptroller certifying that the necessary funds are on deposit in the City Treasury.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess funds, if any, to fund balance, Fund 63022, J.O. No. 990348, Private and Other Contributions-CIP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this activity is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 because this activity is the maintenance or minor modification of existing facilities.
