DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ JUN - 7 2006

WHEREAS, Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger has authorized the California Reading and Literacy Improvement and Public Library Construction and Renovation Bond Act of 2006 be placed on the June 2006 ballot; and

WHEREAS, population increases have resulted in increasing library usage, and local governments are struggling to meet the need for library construction and renovation; and

WHEREAS, the California State Library has identified over 500 unfunded library construction projects statewide, totaling more than \$4 billion; and

WHEREAS, approval of Proposition 81 would authorize the State of California to sell \$600 million in bonds to assist local governments in the construction and renovation of public libraries: and

WHEREAS, approved projects will combine state matching funds representing 65 percent of total project costs, with 35 percent in locally generated funds, resulting in nearly \$900 million being spent in local communities; and

WHEREAS, fighting illiteracy starts early in life, and public libraries have been essential partners with our schools in dealing with this problem; and

WHEREAS, public libraries offer reading programs for young children and literacy services for adults and families that complement the formal education system; and

WHEREAS, at the April 5, 2006 meeting of the City of San Diego Board of Library

Commissioners the Board unanimously passed a motion supporting Proposition 81; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has requested funding for the Skyline Hills Branch

Library in the amount of \$7,487,841 which was not funded in the 3rd cycle of Proposition 14;

and

WHEREAS, Proposition 81 will give first priority to eligible applications not funded in

the 3rd cycle of Proposition 14; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City of San Diego

supports the passage of Proposition 81, the California Reading and Literacy Improvements and

Public Library Construction and Renovation Bond Act of 2006, on the June 6, 2006 statewide

election ballot.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no public funds shall be used in the campaign for

Proposition 81.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this

resolution after its adoption to Yes for Libraries headquarters.
