

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 301514

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 08 2006

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has deemed it necessary to enact regulations governing pedicabs, pedicab operators, and pedicab owners to protect the general safety and welfare of passengers using pedicabs for hire;

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transit System [MTS] currently regulates all vehicles-for-hire within its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS, greater efficiency and better service that would protect the general safety and welfare of pedicab passengers may result from MTS administering the pedicab regulatory program:


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the members of the MTS Board that also serve on the City Council of San Diego, are hereby authorized and empowered to request, for and on behalf of said City, a recommendation that the regulation of pedicabs be transferred to MTS.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City's representatives on the MTS Board introduce a resolution directing MTS staff to investigate the legal authority and administrative efficacy of MTS regulating pedicabs, and directing MTS staff to report back to the MTS Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, upon completion of this report, the MTS Board and the Council of The City of San Diego, can take any further action to implement the transfer, if so desired.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this activity is not a project for the purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c)(3) and 15378(b)(2) because this activity is a general policy and procedure making.
