RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FY 2006 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has been identified by the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) as the "core city" for the San Diego Urban Area's participation in the federal FY 2006 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP), specifically in the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI); and

WHEREAS, the Urban Area has been defined as the County of San Diego, the related special districts, and the eighteen incorporated cities in the County; and

WHEREAS, as the core city, the City of San Diego will be the grantee and administrator of a \$6,392,000 homeland security grant to the San Diego Urban Area; and

WHEREAS, the HSGP provides financial assistance to address the unique equipment, training, planning and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density urban areas, and to assist them in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, protect against, respond to and recover from threats or terrorist attacks, major disasters and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the HSGP also provides funding to complete the acquisition of personal protective equipment for regional first responders, to enhance interoperable communications throughout the region, and to provide Weapons of Mass Destruction Awareness training for first responders and other government employees; and

WHEREAS, the HSGP will also provide funding under the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program and the State Homeland Security Program that will benefit the City of San

Diego and the region; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, Chief Operating Officer, or the Deputy Chief Operating Officer

for Public Safety/Homeland Security, is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to apply for,

accept and expend grant funds from the FY 2006 Homeland Security Grant Program as the

City's authorized agent.

2. That the Mayor, Chief Operating Officer, or the Deputy Chief Operating Officer

for Public Safety/Homeland Security, is authorized, to take all necessary steps to secure the grant

funds, and to execute and submit all documents necessary to comply with the FY 2006

Homeland Security Grant Program requirements.
