DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL - 5 2006

WHEREAS, the National Management Association [NMA] is a professional, not-for-profit national organization consisting of 25,000 members and 170 chapters dedicated to improving the quality of leadership and management through the education and development of its members; and

WHEREAS, NMA is dedicated to managerial excellence, personal and professional growth, and leadership development. The following principles identify NMA's core beliefs and provide the basis for the Association's Mission Statement. NMA believes in the highest standards of personal and organizational integrity and respect for the individual. NMA believes in lifelong learning, continuous improvement, and the development of a workforce capable of sustaining a competitive posture in the global economy; and

WHEREAS, NMA encourages professionalism in management by conducting over 20 annual noontime professional development programs, providing a course on "Communication Skills for Managers;" and, in partnership with San Diego State University, developed and produced an "Advanced Leadership Skills Program" that was held from January through May 2005; and

WHEREAS, in December 2005, as part of the San Diego Coalition for the Homeless Annual Holiday Magic for Homeless Children, NMA San Diego members and their children collected over 200 toys and spent hours gift wrapping toys for more than 3,000 homeless children; in August 2005, NMA raised funds for the Family Justice Center through a Charity

Golf Tournament; and, in May 2006, NMA continued its tradition of community service through participation in the Adopt-a-Block Saturday for Second Chance, and


