WHEREAS, Blair currently serves on the Board of Directors of the California Children's Hospitals Association, the Child Health Corporation of America, and the Healthcare Association of San Diego and Imperial Counties; and

WHEREAS, Blair was appointed by President Clinton and served for three years as a member of the U.S.-Mexico Border Health Commission; and

WHEREAS, under Blair's leadership, Children's has become one of the leading pediatric hospitals in America and was the country's first children's hospital to receive the prestigious Ernest A. Codman Award; and

WHEREAS, Blair received the California Children's Association Award of Merit for his outstanding contributions to the California health care community; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize the vital services that Blair Sadler has provided the citizens of San Diego.
