A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO RATIFY THE JUNE 22, 2006 PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE [PAC] ELECTION RESULTS FOR THE CROSSROADS REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2002, the City Council of the City of San Diego [Council] by Resolution No. R-296253, adopted the formation procedures for the Crossroads Redevelopment Project Area Committee [PAC]; and

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2003, the Council by Resolution No. R-298702, amended the formation procedures for the Crossroads Redevelopment PAC; and

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2005 the Council by Ordinance No. O-19174 authorized the Crossroads Redevelopment PAC for six years; and

WHEREAS, an election was conducted on June 22, 2006, after being notice and according to the established procedures enumerated within the documents approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, a representative from the City Clerk's Office attended the election to ensure its validity; and

WHEREAS, the elected members of the PAC have submitted to this Council information establishing the qualifications of each person relative to district, category or organization as appropriate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the persons elected as members of the PAC for the Crossroads Redevelopment Project Area, as noted by the City Clerk's verification of the election results of June 22, 2006, are approved as newly elected members to the PAC.

2. That the Council finds that the election results of June 22, 2006 are valid and binding in accordance with the procedures so adopted by Resolution No. R-298702.

3. That the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego is directed to consult with and obtain the advice of the PAC pursuant to the provisions of the California Community Redevelopment Law (California Health and Safety Code section 33000 et seq.).
