

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 301809DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE AUG 04 2006

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE AN IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS; DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE A FISCAL ANALYSIS; AND ASSIGNING THE MAYOR AUTHORSHIP OF THE BALLOT ARGUMENT; ALL REGARDING THE BALLOT MEASURE ON RETIREMENT BENEFIT INCREASES.

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Article 7, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code allows the City Council to give direction to the City Attorney to prepare an impartial analysis of any proposed ballot measure, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Article 7, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code allows the City Council to direct the Mayor to prepare a fiscal impact analysis of any proposed legislative act; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Article 7, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code allows the City Council to assign authorship and signing of the ballot argument to one or more Councilmembers, including the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on March 27, 2006, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-19473 (N.S.), placing the proposition to amend Article IX of the San Diego City Charter by adding section 143.1 regarding retirement benefit increases, on the November 7, 2006 ballot; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Attorney is directed to prepare an impartial analysis of the proposed ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet and to deliver said analysis to the Office of the City Clerk, Elections Section, no later than August 21, 2006.

2. That the Mayor is directed to prepare, in consultation with the Independent Budget Analyst, a fiscal impact analysis of the proposed ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet and to deliver said analysis to the Office of the City Clerk, Elections Section, no later than August 21, 2006.

3. That the Mayor is authorized to sign and file a written argument in support of the ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet and to deliver said argument to the Office of the City Clerk, Elections Section, no later than August 24, 2006.

4. That the Mayor will designate one Councilmember to also sign the written argument in support of the ballot measure.
