RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR AN AS-NEEDED GENERAL REQUIREMENTS CONTACT FOR THE PARK & RECREATION DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST BIDDER; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS; AND FINDING NO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT BY THIS ACTION.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Contract Documents and Technical Specifications for the General Requirements Contract for the Park and Recreation Department, to provide as-needed construction of minor improvements at various locations, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. \(\overline{\psi}.\psi\). \(250120\), are approved.
- 2. That after advertising for bids, the Mayor or his designee is authorized to award the contract to the lowest responsible and reliable bidder for the General Requirements Contract for the Park and Recreation Department for as-needed construction for a \$50,000 minimum and not to exceed \$2,000,000 between June 1, 2006 and May 31, 2007, with an option for the Mayor or his designee to extend the contract for up to one additional year and up to an additional \$2,000,000; provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.
- 3. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$4,000,0000 from Fund No. 30244 (CIP Construction Fund) is authorized, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the above referenced contract, of which \$2,000,000 is from Fiscal Year 2007 and \$2,000,000 is from Fiscal

Year 2008, contingent on the exercise of the one-year option and provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.

4. That the above contract is not a project and therefore is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c)(3).
