WHEREAS, the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Division staff have been working collaboratively with San Diego Coastkeeper and the San Diego City School District to develop science curricula for kindergarten though high school children entitled "Project SWELL — Stewardship: Water Education for Lifelong Leadership" to educate the public about urban runoff and its effects on water quality;

WHEREAS, intellectual property rights have been created in the development of the Project SWELL curricula, and all such rights are now vested jointly with the City of San Diego and San Diego Coastkeeper;

WHEREAS, the City of Oceanside and the Oceanside Unified School District wish to use the Project SWELL 5<sup>th</sup> grade curricula in the Oceanside school's science program;

AND WHEREAS, the City of Oceanside and the Oceanside Unified School District are willing to pay a license fee for the right to use these materials for a five year period;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into a copyright license and fee agreement, for and on behalf of said City, for a term not to exceed five years with the City of Oceanside School District, for the Project SWELL 5<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller accept and deposit a copyright license fee in an amount of \$10,500 from the City of Oceanside School District into the Think Blue Fund No.105081 upon receipt of the fully executed agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego finds that this activity is not a project because this activity does not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and is therefore not subject to from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(2).
