DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE AUG - 8 2006

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AS
RESPONSIBLE AGENCY REGARDING THE FINAL
SUPPLEMENTAL SUBSEQUENT ENVIRONMENTAL
IMPACT REPORT, SAN VICENTE SURGE CONTROL
FACILITY, EMERGENCY STORAGE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Water Authority [CWA] and the United States Army Corps of Engineers [ACOE], as joint Lead Agencies, adopted and certified a final joint Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement [final joint EIR/EIS] (SCH No. 1993011028) (No. LDR R&C file No. 95-18) on or in 1996;

WHEREAS, the final joint EIR/EIS addressed the environmental impacts associated with the Emergency Storage Project [ESP] which includes the expansion and use of the San Vicente Reservoir and Lake Hodges Dam and Reservoir;

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego was a Responsible Agency for the final joint EIR/EIS under the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, as amended, [CEQA] (California Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq);

WHEREAS, on May 4, 1998 the Council of the City of San Diego adopted Resolution No. R-290003, wherein the Council considered and reviewed the issues and information, including all public comments, discussed and contained in the final joint EIR/EIS in connection with the use of the San Vicente Reservoir and Lake Hodges Dam and Reservoir as part of the ESP;

WHEREAS, on or about February 2005, CWA certified a Final Supplemental Subsequent Environmental Impact Report [SSEIR] (SCH No. 1993011028) addressing

additional environmental impacts associated with the San Vicente Surge Control Facility which is a part of the Emergency Storage Project [ESP]; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is a Responsible Agency for the SSEIR; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. Pursuant to the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations Section 15096(f)), the City has considered the SSEIR and the environmental effects of the project as shown in the SSEIR;

2. The City has responsibility for mitigating or avoiding only the direct or indirect environmental effects of those parts of the project which it will carry out;

3. The City is responsible for carrying out the following parts of the project: the granting or conveyance of those interests in various real property to CWA as fully described in Resolution No. R- 301843 (R-2007-102 COR COPY);

4. With respect to those parts of the project that the City will carry out, there are no direct or indirect environmental effects over which it has control or oversight;

5. There are no feasible alternatives or feasible mitigation measures that are within City Powers that will avoid or lessen any significant effect from the project; and


6. Pursuant to the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations Section 15091(a)(2)), the SSEIR as adopted and certified by CWA identifies one or more significant environmental effects of the project; however, any and all necessary project changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of CWA or other public agencies and not the City making the findings herein. Such changes and/or alterations have been adopted by CWA or other public agencies or can and should be adopted by such other agencies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, pursuant to CEQA (California Public Resources Code Section 21081) and the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations Section 15091), the City Council adopts the Findings made in the SSEIR with respect to the project, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 301842 and incorporated herein by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, pursuant to the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations Section 15096(i)), the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of

Determination [NOD] with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding the above project.
