A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA B SAN DIEGO COLLEGE AREA

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has established a Residential Permit Parking Program to mitigate the impact on residential areas of long-term commuter parking generated by a facility such as a large college, a hospital, or a major industrial center. To alleviate the adverse effects of vehicle congestion caused by long-term parking by non-residents in residential neighborhoods;

WHEREAS, a Residential Permit Parking Area was established in the San Diego State University area [Permit Parking Area B] in 1984;

WHEREAS, a majority of the residents of the 5000-block of La Dorna Street, currently within Permit Parking B, have submitted a petition requesting that a portion of the east and west curblines of the 5000 block of La Dorna Street be added to the Residential Permit Parking Area B;


WHEREAS, as detailed in Report to Council No. 06-108, the evidence regarding the impacts of non-resident parking on the 5000 block of La Dorna Street meet most of the criteria in Municipal Code section 86.2005 for adding a portion of the 5000 block of La Dorna Street to Permit Parking Area B;

AND WHEREAS, as detailed in Report to Council No. 06-108, the Mayor has followed the procedures specified in Municipal Code sections 86.2006 and 86.2007 for considering adding of the portion of the 5000-block of La Dorna Street to Permit Parking Area B; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that pursuant to the authority conferred by and in accordance with the requirements of Division 20 of Article 6 of Chapter 8 of the San Diego Municipal Code, that portion of the 5000-block of La Dorna Street, between Montezuma Road and: the northerly property line of 5075 La Dorna Street on the east curblin, and the northerly property line of 5074 La Dorna Street on the west curblin, is hereby added to Residential Permit Area B.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego finds that this activity is the modification of an existing facility that does not result in an expansion beyond the existing use, and is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301.


