WHEREAS, the philosophy underlying women's suffrage is the belief in "natural rights," which are the rights of women to govern themselves and choose their own representatives, a defining feature of full citizenship; and

WHEREAS, August 26, 2006 is the 86th anniversary of women earning the right to vote in the United States; and

WHEREAS, in July of 1848, Elizabeth Cady Stanton's famous speech, "A Declaration of Sentiments" commenced the first women's rights convention in Seneca Falls, New York; and

WHEREAS, this convention marked American women as the first in the world to voice organized demands for a woman's right to vote; and

WHEREAS, the 72-year struggle ended in 1920 with the ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment to the United States Constitution which states that, "The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of sex"; and

WHEREAS, since 1971, August 26th has been recognized in the United States as Women's Equality Day; and

WHEREAS, the observance of Women's Equality Day not only commemorates the passage of the Nineteenth Amendment, but also calls attention to women's continuing efforts toward full equality; and

WHEREAS, on August 26th there will be a Women's Equality Day parade in Sacramento, as well as celebrations in San Diego and throughout the United States; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does herby proclaim August 26, 2006, to be "WOMEN'S EQUALITY DAY" in the City of San Diego.
