DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE SEP 2 9 2006

WHEREAS, Hoover High School, the home of the Cardinals, based in San Diego's Mid-City community, opened its doors to 960 students on September 2, 1930; and

WHEREAS, in the winter of 1930, Hoover High School's first basketball team began league play; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 California Interscholastic Federation (CIF) Championship, which governs public and private high school sports, was the first for Hoover High School basketball since the back-to-back CIF titles in 1961 and 1962; and

WHEREAS, last year, Hoover High School Boys' Varsity Basketball Team, finished with a record of 28-6, the most victorious season in school's history; and

WHEREAS, Hoover High School Boys' Varsity Basketball Team won both the 2006 San Diego Division II CIF Championship and the Central League Championship; and

WHEREAS, Hoover High School's Boys' Varsity Basketball Team, under the leadership of third year Coach Ollie Goulston, Student Sports Magazine All-American JayDee Luster, and standouts Norvell Arnold, Ryon White and Todd Doxey, has an impressive 71-27 record, with two appearances in the CIF finals, one championship, and two league titles; and

conference team in Division I or II to ever win a state playoff game; and

WHEREAS, Hoover High School finished its 2006 season ranked No. 2 in San Diego

County overall and No. 10 in the State of California's second division; NOW, THEREFORE,

accomplishments of Hoover High School Boys' Varsity Basketball team and wish them the best

of luck in the upcoming season.

be "HOOVER HIGH SCHOOL BOYS' VARSITY BASKETBALL DAY" in the City of

San Diego.
