BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the assessment fee schedule contained in the Mira Mesa Public Facilities Financing Plan and Facilities Benefit Assessment, Fiscal Year 2007, as adopted and approved on \_\_\_\_\_SEP 1 9 2006 \_\_\_\_\_, by Resolution No. R-\_\_301860 \_\_\_\_, [R-2007-91], is declared to be an appropriate and applicable development impact fee schedule [DIF] for all properties within the Mira Mesa Community that have either never been assessed under the Mira Mesa Public Facilities Financing Plan or have not otherwise agreed to the payment of Facilities Benefit Assessment fees as prescribed by the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Docket Supporting Information [Report to the City Council No. Olo-III ], including all exhibits and attachments thereto, and the text contained in the Mira Mesa Public Facilities Financing Plan and Facilities Benefit Assessment, Fiscal Year 2007, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-301860 [R-2007-91], are incorporated by reference into this Resolution as support and justification for satisfaction of findings required pursuant to California Government Code sections 66001(a) and 66001(b) for imposition of DIFs. Specifically, it is determined and found that this documentation:

- 1. Identifies the purpose of the DIF;
- 2. Identifies the use to which the DIF is to be put;

- 3. Demonstrates how there is a reasonable relationship between the DIF's use and the type of development project on which the DIF is imposed; and
- 4. Demonstrates how there is a reasonable relationship between the need for the public facility and the type of development project on which the DIF is imposed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this activity is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
