RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NO. 3 WITH AMERICAN ASPHALT SOUTH, . INC.; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION AND EXPENITURE OF ADDITIONAL FUNDING; AND FINDING NO NEW ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT BY THIS ACTION; ALL IN CONNECTION WITH SLURRY SEAL OF VARIOUS STREETS CITY WIDE GROUP S-10.

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2005, the Council of the City of San Diego adopted Resolution Number R-300892 which approved the specifications for Slurry Sealing Various Streets City Wide Fiscal Year 2006, Group S-10 and authorized the advertising and award of the contract to lowest responsible bidder in an amount not to exceed \$1,216,430; and

WHEREAS, the specifications for that contract included an Additive Alternate #2 which was part of the competitive bid; and

WHEREAS, this contract was awarded on May 9, 2006 to American Asphalt South, Inc. in the amount of \$817,829.80 and did not include the Additive Alternate #2 because sufficient funds were not available to award that work; and

WHEREAS, Streets Division of the General Services Department has now identified funds to award the additive alternate work and amend the contract to include that scope of work; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows;

1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, Change Order No. 3 on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.

RR-301956, issued in connection with the contract between the City of San Diego and American Asphalt South, Inc., said contract having been filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-300892, amounting to a net increase in the contract price of \$773,029.80.

- 2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend an additional \$792,529.80 from Fund 100 as follows: \$773,029.80 for Change Order No. 3 with American Asphalt South, Inc.; and \$19,500.00 for City project management and inspection costs.
- 3. That this activity is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 because this activity is the repair and maintenance of existing facilities.
