BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- That the Mayor, or designee, is hereby authorized to apply to the State of
   California Department of Transportation [DOT] for grant funds under the Community Based Transportation Planning Grant Program for the following communities:
  - a. Rosecrans Corridor Study;
  - b. Hillcrest Mobility Plan Phase II;
  - c. Mission Valley Trolley Access Improvements;
  - d. Balboa Avenue Revitalization Feasibility Study;
  - e. Crossroads/El Cajon Boulevard; and
  - f. San Ysidro Port of Entry Mobility Plan.
- 2. That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to apply to the Environmental Justice: Context-Sensitive Planning Grant Program for funding for the following of City projects [Projects]:
  - a. Barrio Logan Community Plan Land Use/Transportation Planning
  - b. Linda Vista Community Transportation Needs Study
  - c. Palm Avenue Mobility Plan
- 3. That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized to execute all documents, including contracts, sub-contracts, agreements, extensions, renewals, and/or amendments required by the DOT, which may be necessary to carry out and administer obligations,

responsibilities and duties under these grants, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed agreement.

- 4. That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized and empowered to take all necessary actions to secure funds from the State of California for the Project.
- That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a separate interest-bearing funds for the grants.
- 6. That the City auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$2,709,500 from DOT funds under the Community-Based Transportation Planning Grant Program and the Environmental Justice for the purpose of preparing studies and related expenses, upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this activity is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15262, as the activity constitutes feasibility and planning studies.
