A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REINSTATING THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO SWIM TEAM FOR THE DURATION OF FISCAL YEAR 2007.

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2006, the City of San Diego's Park and Recreation

Department issued a letter to participants in the Blue Level Swim Program notifying them of the administrative decision to discontinue the program effective December 4, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has held a public hearing to discuss the decision to discontinue the program; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the City's Blue Level Swim Program will be reinstated for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2007.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council recommends that the City create a task force of stakeholders to "reengineer" the City of San Diego Swim Team program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and the Park and Recreation Department should return to the City Council during the course of the budgetary review process with proposals to eliminate the deficit within the City's aquatics budget while retaining the City of San Diego Swim Team program in FY 2007 and for future years.
