A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT AT MARY LANYON FAY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN THE CITY HEIGHTS REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.

WHEREAS, the City Heights Redevelopment Project Area ("Project Area") is a redevelopment project area adopted by the Redevelopment Agency ("Agency") pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Law (California Health and Safety Code section 33000 et seq.);

WHEREAS, the Agency is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the Agency funds projects to improve economic and physical conditions in designated areas of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified School District ("District") is building the new Mary Lanyon Fay Elementary School in connection with the Safe Routes to School Project ("Project") which includes many public improvements; and

WHEREAS, Agency and District desire to cooperate in the construction of additional public improvements designed to improve the safety of school children and other pedestrians in the neighborhood of the school; and

WHEREAS, Agency wishes to contribute to District tax increment funds in an amount of fifty percent (50%), not to exceed \$100,000 as its contribution, of the total Project cost, for the purpose of constructing traffic calming public improvements at the Mary Lanyon Fay Elementary School to serve the safety needs of the students, faculty, and general public by

reducing traffic speeds at the intersection of 52nd Street and Ottilie Place; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Council make the necessary findings that the contribution of up to \$100,000 from the City Heights Redevelopment Project Area to the District for public improvements at Mary Lanyon Fay Elementary School for the Safe Routes to School Project is necessary and of benefit to the City Heights Redevelopment Project Area.
- 2. That this activity is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3). This determination is predicated on Section 15004 of the Guidelines, which provides direction to lead agencies on the appropriate timing for environmental review.

 Construction activities related to the program will require further review under the provisions of CEQA.
