WHEREAS, on July 31, 2006, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-19523 establishing the policy of the City of San Diego to reorganize the departments of the City to improve the level of services to the citizens and to reduce the cost of providing such services [BPR Ordinance]; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has commenced the Business Process review of all City departments; and

WHEREAS, the Final Report on the Human Resources/Personnel Re-engineering Study
[Human Resources BPR] to review and re-engineer the City's application of human resources
policies and procedures has been completed; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor's Report is accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Comptroller, pursuant to Section 2 of the BPR Ordinance, is authorized to adjust expenditure and revenue appropriations as detailed in the Mayor's Report.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Comptroller, with the assistance of the City Attorney, is authorized and directed to prepare an ordinance amending the FY 2007 Appropriations Ordinance in accordance with Mayor's Report and for the approval of the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney is authorized and directed to prepare any necessary amendments to the Administrative Code to reflect the restructuring of City departments in accordance with the Mayor's Report and for the approval of the City Council.
