RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 302076

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE NOV 22 2006

WHEREAS, in 1885, the Chinese Mission School opened under the sponsorship of the California Chinese Mission Auxiliary of the Congregational American Missionary Association in rented church facilities at Eighth & D Streets; and

WHEREAS, in 1909, the Mission moved from 663 First Avenue to 645 First Avenue to land donated by George Marston; and

WHEREAS, in 1927, the Mission dedicated a new brick sanctuary and dormitory on the same site as the wooden structure at 645 First Avenue. During the construction phase, programs were held at the Chinese Consolidated Benevolent Association Building; and

WHEREAS, in 1960, ground was broken at 1750 47th Street for first phase construction of new church facilities, sanctuary, and Sunday school classrooms. The property at 645 First Avenue was sold and during the construction period services and Sunday school were held at St. Paul's Episcopal Church; and

WHEREAS, in 1971, the Community Center was dedicated at the 47th Street site; and

WHEREAS, in 1988, four acres of undeveloped land in Tierrasanta were purchased; and

WHEREAS, in 2003, after a long and laborious effort, the Church received a conditional use permit and its discretionary permits for the Tierrasanta property. Mr. Burnsam Dang, Ms. Emma L. Hom, and Mr. Roger H. Lee spearheaded the planning, designing, permitting, and construction; and

WHEREAS, in July, 2005, the Church held its groundbreaking ceremony signaling the start of construction on its fourth Church campus in 120 years; and

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2006, the Church celebrates another milestone of service and leadership in the City of San Diego, the inaugural services at the new Church site in Tierrasanta; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, recognizes and salutes the Chinese Community Church for being a value to the community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the 15th of October, 2006, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "CHINESE COMMUNITY CHURCH DAY" in the City of San Diego.
