DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE DEC 1 2006

WHEREAS, our aging population is one of the most dynamic demographics affecting families and societies all over the world; and

WHEREAS, the growing social and economic demands of those over 65 is a significant concern for policy makers, businesses, and healthcare providers; and

WHEREAS, Filial Piety, a love and respect for one's parents and ancestors, has roots in Buddhist and Confucian thought, is considered the first virtue in Chinese culture, is common in almost all of China's diverse religious beliefs, and is a value shared by most of the world's cultures; and
