WHEREAS, Government Code section 87306 requires agencies to amend their conflict of interest codes whenever an amendment is necessitated by changed circumstances, including the creation of new positions that must be designated, and relevant changes in the duties assigned to existing positions; and

WHEREAS, the Financial Management Department has proposed changes to its code to include new positions that had not been previously designated, remove positions previously designated but now appropriately included in other City departments' codes, and to update required filing categories for designated positions; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Financial Management Department's proposed changes to Appendix A and Appendix B of that department's Conflict of Interest Code are hereby approved and incorporated into its Conflict of Interest Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that revised Appendix A and Appendix B to the Conflict of Interest Code for the Financial Management Department be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-302225.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the revised Conflict of Interest Code for the

Financial Management Department shall become effective on the date of final passage.
