AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH PARSONS BRINCKERHOFF QUADE & DOUGLAS, INC. FOR THE CARROLL CANYON ROAD EXTENSION PROJECT

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, a First Amendment to the Agreement with Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade & Douglas, Inc. for professional preliminary and final engineering and design services on the Carroll Canyon Road Extension Project, under the terms and conditions set forth in the document on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 19575

Section. 2. That the Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$152,471 from CIP 52-392.0, Carroll Canyon Road Extension with the funds received from the City of Carlsbad for the purpose of funding the aforementioned first amendment to the consultant agreement with Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade & Douglas, Inc., contingent upon the Auditor and Controller first certifying that the funds are or will be available in the City Treasury.

Section 3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. A full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
