AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-19522 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2006-2007 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING AN ADDITIONAL \$4,513,653 IN BY ACCEPTING PROPOSITION 42 MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL TAX REVENUE FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND INCREASING THE APPROPRIATION IN THE GENERAL FUND IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,037,844 FOR STREETS DIVISION OPERATING BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2007 Appropriations Ordinance, Ordinance No. O-19522, budgeted and appropriated \$5,000,000 in Proposition 42 funds;

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has received \$4,513,653 more in Fiscal Year 07 Proposition 42 funds than the originally budgeted \$5,000,000;

AND WHEREAS, the Streets Division of the General Services Department has identified capital improvement needs within the City that can be funded by increasing the Streets Division operating budget; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept from the State of California and appropriate an additional \$4,513,653 in Fiscal Year 2007 Proposition 42 funding; Fund 30307.

Section 2. That the Fiscal Year 2007 Appropriation Ordinance, Ordinance No. O-19522, be amended by increasing the appropriation in Fund 100, Department 534, Streets

Division Operating Fund by \$6,037,844 by transferring funds from Fund 30307, Proposition 42.

Section 3. That the Streets Division of the General Services Department is authorized to expend \$6,037,844 from the Streets Division Operating fund Fund 100, Dept. 534, for the purposes of completing additional road maintenance work.

Section 4. That the Council of the City of San Diego finds that this activity is not a project because this activity is a government fiscal activity which does not involve a commitment to a project that which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment, which is excluded from the definition of a project pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4), and is therefore not subject to from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).

Section 5. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 6. That this Ordinance shall take effect and in force upon final passage.
