AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A MASTER LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE ACQUISITION OF MOVIVE AND PUBLIC SAFETY EQUIPMENT THROUGH A MASTER LEASE-PURCHASE IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$14.6 MILLION AND TAKING OTHER ACTIONIS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, from time to time the City of San Diego [City] has acquired equipment for the purposes of providing public services; and

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2007, the City issued a Request for Proposals for, among other purposes, to solicit financing proposals for motive equipment and the City-wide enterprise resource planning system; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the issuance of the RFP, staff was advised that it was necessary to finance the last segment of the City's Public Safety Communication's project; and

WHEREAS, Koch Financial Corporation [Koch] was the sole responsive bidder for the motive equipment, and City staff has determined that the terms of the bid for the motive equipment is at a cost effective rate to the City; and

WHEREAS, Koch has indicated that it would be willing to provide advantageous financing for completion of the Public Safety Communication's project [collectively the motive equipment and the Public Safety Communication equipment is collectively referred to as the Project], and staff has determined that it would be advantageous to the City to accept the Koch proposal; and

WHEREAS, that acquisition cost of the Project will be in an amount not to exceed \$14.6 million (comprised of \$11.6 million for the motive equipment and \$3.0 million for the Public

Safety Communication's equipment) and the City has determined to acquire the Project though a lease-purchase arrangement with Koch; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.
