

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 19614 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 07 2007

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
ANGLE PARKING ON FIRST AVENUE BETWEEN
REDWOOD STREET AND PALM STREET.

WHEREAS, the residents of the City of San Diego residing on First Avenue between Redwood Street and Palm Street submitted a petition requesting angle parking on said street; and

WHEREAS, the City Transportation Engineering Division of the Engineering & Capital Projects Department reviewed the petition and determined, using accepted traffic engineering principles, that angle parking can be installed with an adequate margin of safety; and

WHEREAS, a request has been made to keep two parallel parking spaces at 2950 First Avenue for the purpose of preserving an unobstructed line of sight when exiting the property;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to the authority conferred by and in accordance with the provisions of California Vehicle Code section 22503 and San Diego Municipal Code section 86.03, the creation of an angle parking zone on First Avenue between Redwood Street and Palm Street, is hereby authorized, except that two parallel parking spaces shall be maintained north of the driveway of 2950 First Avenue.

Section 2. That the installation of the necessary signs or markings is hereby authorized to be made on said street, and the regulations hereinabove imposed shall become effective upon the installation of such signs or markings, or 30 days after the final passage of this ordinance, whichever comes later.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, since a written copy was made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.

Section 5. That this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 because this action is the minor alteration of an existing facility with a negligible expansion beyond the existing use.
