A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING ALL RIGHTS OF WAY FOR THE PARK BOULEVARD AT HARBOR DRIVE PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the plan for a Park to Bay Link and the Ballpark District Plan, contemplates an open view corridor and easy pedestrian access to the San Diego Bay from Balboa Park; and

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation on behalf of the Redevelopment Agency and with the cooperation of the City, seeks to develop a pedestrian bridge at the intersection of Park Boulevard and Harbor Drive in the East Village neighborhood of downtown, adjacent to the Baseball Park; and

WHEREAS, the bridge structure will provide a safe, convenient, and legal pedestrian crossing over Harbor Drive and will help improve traffic circulation, fire and life safety and access to and from the Waterfront, Barrio Logan, and the rapidly developing East Village Neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the pedestrian bridge requires various rights of way so that it can be configured and sited to provide a high level of aesthetic quality as a gateway to the downtown area; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the mayor or his designee is authorized to accept all necessary rights of way required for the development of the Park Boulevard Pedestrian Bridge.
