
RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 302302

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE FEB 14 2007

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and empowered for and on behalf of the City of San Diego to make an application to the State of California Department of Transportation [Caltrans] for \$227,000 under the Environmental Justice: Context-Sensitive Planning Grant Program to develop a "Preferred Route to School Plan" and Condition Assessment; and
2. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized and empowered to take all necessary actions to secure funding from Caltrans for the aforementioned grant; and
3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$227,000 if grant funding is secured and contingent upon the City Auditor and Comptroller certifying that the necessary funds are or will be on deposit in the City Treasury; and
4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant.
5. That this activity is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c)(2) because it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.


