A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND EXPENDITURE OF STATE GRANT FUNDS FOR THE MISSION BEACH PARK SECURITY CAMERA SYSTEM IN THE MISSION BEACH PARK AREA.

WHEREAS, In March 2002, California voters approved Proposition 40, the \$2.6 billion 2002 State Resources Bond "Safe Neighborhood Parks, Clean Water, Clean Air, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002; and

WHEREAS, this action authorizes the Mayor or his representative to apply for a total of \$45,000, a portion of the 2002 Resources Bond Per Capita funding allocated to Council District 2; and

WHEREAS, \$45,000 in generous community funds donated through the San Diego Police Foundation will complete funding for this project; and

WHEREAS, The installation of a security camera system on park property in Mission

Beach (Belmont) Park will provide video security as a police force multiplier to reduce crime in
the community of Mission Beach; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his representative is authorized to apply to the State of California for \$45,000 Per Capita funds under the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 for grant funds for purchase and installation of a monitored security camera system at Mission Beach Park [Project].

2. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized on behalf of the City, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, which may be necessary to secure funding and to carry out all obligations, responsibilities and duties of Project.

3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept the Grant funds and establish a special interest-bearing fund for the Grant.

4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$45,000 from the Mission Beach Park Security Camera System grant fund, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.

5. That this activity is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State Guidelines Section 15301.
