RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN
DIEGO PROCLAIMING APRIL 11, 2007 AS GLOBAL
WARMING AWARENESS DAY

WHEREAS, Anton Corbin, a Graphic Design Teacher at Kearny High School, initiated an effort - culminating in "Global Warming Awareness Day" on April 11, 2007 - to educate local high school students on ways they can help alleviate global warming;



WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has taken concrete steps towards becoming more energy efficient and using renewable fueled generation through the likes of Council Policy 900-02 (energy conservation in City operations); Council Policy 900-14 (Green Building Policy); Council Policy 900-18 (City purchase of energy efficient products); and Resolution R-2002-895 (the San Diego Sustainable Community Program);

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has demonstrated a long-standing commitment to stemming global warming and is uniquely situated (with its climate, natural resources, academic resources, etc) to be a hub for green industry; NOW, THEREFORE,
